

Stewardship Requirements

Faith Lutheran School

"Raising up families and followers of Jesus Christ"

Families with children enrolled at Faith Lutheran School are required to contribute volunteer hours, called "stewardship hours."

Family members work through the classroom teacher or the school office to complete stewardship hours. Volunteer opportunities include class field trips; special school events; participation in Partners in Education (P.I.E.); facility repair, cleaning, or maintenance; project preparation for teachers (cutting, etc.); work on bulletin boards; and other activities.

Each family is responsible for seeking out volunteer opportunities, completing timesheets and turning in recorded hours.

Stewardship timesheets are available at the school office. Timesheets need to be signed by an authorizing staff member or P.I.E. chairperson for hours completed. Hours may also be submitted through our website: www.flschool.org > Parents > Report Stewardship Hours.

Stewardship hours are required as follows:

Preschool 4 hours per school year
Pre-Kindergarten (3 Days) 6 hours per school year
Jr. Kindergarten 10 hours per school year
Kindergarten thru 8th Grade 15 hours per school year

Families with multiple children work only the hours required for the highest grade.

Completion Dates

Half of the required hours must be completed by January 31. The remaining half must be completed by the last day of school. Hours not completed by these dates will be billed at the rate of \$10 per hour.

Instead of completing the hours, families may pay \$10 per hour for the required hours.

Hours completed after the last day of school apply to the next school year. Excess hours cannot be held over to the next school year.
