Visitors Policy



Childcare Drop-in Policy

For those families that don't normally use childcare, you may find using childcare helpful on occasions when you know you won't be able to pick your child up on time due to an appointment or other conflict. For students age 3 through age 11, Faith Lutheran Childcare Center has a drop-in option to help you in these situations. Students 12 and above may use Homework Club.

To maintain their license, childcare has a ratio of staff-to-children they must strictly adhere to. As a result, if you would like to use drop-in care, and your child is in preschool, pre-k, or Jr. K, let childcare know a minimum of one day before you need care so that correct staffing can be scheduled. The best method is to email the childcare director, Julie Miller, at j.miller@ faithcampus.org. If you have a child in K-4th grade and find you need care after school, you may still call the school office the day of and have your child go to childcare.

If your child is in a morning half-day class (preschool, pre-k, or Jr. K), please make sure to pack a lunch for your child.

Billing for drop-in care is billed at the end of the month and will appear on your monthly statement.



Passport Club

Parents of 1st - 6th graders, your child will receive information about our Passport Club from his/her teacher this week. Please be sure to start studying right away!

What is Homework Club? Homework Club is an afterschool, supervised option for students that have aged out of childcare (age 12+)—generally students in 5th-8th grade. It runs from 3:30–6:00 pm. The cost is \$11.00 per day. Homework Club is NOT offered on half days and 'no school' days. Students picked up after 6:00 p.m. will be charged \$2.00 for each minute after 6:00.

To plan for staffing, we are asking students in 5th-8th grade during attendance if they will be going to Homework Club that afternoon. If we are not notified at that time that a student needs Homework Club that day, we will not be able to offer it that afternoon.



Sycamore School is an online Student Information System (SIS) that we have been working to implement over the last several months. We are very excited about the information you will be able to access in Sycamore, like your child's grades, missing assignments, upcoming school events, school calendar, photos, and much more!

Many of the features are ready for you to use right now, but there are some areas of the program that we are still setting up, like billing. When we are done, you will be able to add a payment method (i.e., credit/debit card or automatic bank withdrawal) to pay for tuition, hot lunches or other expenses.

We recently sent out an invitation to set up your login. If you did not receive that invitation, please let the school office know.

Parent/Student Handbook

Parent/Student Handbooks will be sent home with students next Friday, September 18. Please read through the handbook and sign and date the acknowledgement (last page) and return it to school.

There are a few changes/additions to the handbook, so, even if you have read it in the past, please reread it before signing.

If you registered online for school this year, you have already acknowledged having read the handbook and do **NOT** need to turn in the signature page.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Over the years that Faith Lutheran School and Childcare has accepted credit cards for payment, we have absorbed the cost of credit card processing fees, which is anywhere from 3% to 3.5% of the charge. Each year, this has meant a considerable expense to Faith. To prevent having to raise tuition and other fees by a larger percentage to cover these increasing costs, the decision was made to pass this cost on to those who pay by credit card in the manner of a 3% convenience fee as of August 1, 2020. To avoid paying this additional charge, you may pay by check or cash.

Hot Lunch Menus

If you are a new Faith family, hot lunch menus go home the middle of each month for the following month. An extra menu is included for you to record which lunches your child(ren) selected. Menus are due back with payment the next Thursday. If you have more than one student, each student needs their own menu, but please write only one check for the combined total.

The October menu, will go home on **Friday, September 18**. and is **due Thursday, September 24**.

At this time, **only cash or checks are accepted, no credit cards.** We are working on rolling out a credit card option soon.

No child will go hungry. If your child doesn't have a lunch, we will feed him/her, but all unordered lunches result in a \$5 charge.





Absence/Tardy/Early Dismissal

Absence

If your child won't be attending school due to illness or other reason, there are several ways to notify the school to excuse the absence:

- Email the teacher or send a Pass-a-Note through Sycamore
- Call the school office (360-491-1733)
- Go to www.flschool.org, Parents, Report Absence—this emails the school office

If we (teacher/school) are not notified, the absence will be recorded as unexcused. If you would like to pick up homework toward the end of the day, please notify the school/teacher *before* lunch.

Tardy

Students in grades K-8 who are tardy need to go to the school office to get a tardy pass **before** going to their

classroom. If a student is later than 8:35, a parent needs to accompany the student to sign them in at the office. As noted in the Parent/Student Handbook, three tardies equals one absence.

Early Dismissal

If your child will be leaving school early, please email the teacher or call the school office in advance so that we can make sure your child has his/her homework and other important items.

Emergency Contacts / Pick Up List

It is important that Faith has an accurate list of emergency contacts and an up-to-date pick up list for your child(ren). In Sycamore, you are able to add and update these contacts. If someone comes to pick up your child and is not on the pick-up list, we will not release your child to that person, unless you have called the school office to inform us. **Please check to make sure your list is accurate.**

To add or edit contacts, go to app.sycamoreschool.com (our school ID is 4048), log in and select **My Family | Contacts**, and click the **New Contact** button (top right).

The only necessary information is the person's name, phone number, and relationship. Also, indicate if they are an Emergency Contact and/or Authorize Pickup. Make sure to click Add when you are done.

Tuition Payment

When you bring your tuition payment to the school office, please put it in the slot in the safe to the left of the school office window. You no longer have to wait in line to place it in the in-box in the office.

Please make sure you write your student(s) name in the memo line so that it is credited to the correct account.

Medication Authorization

If you would like to have medication kept in the office for administering to your child (i.e., Epi-pen, Benadryl, ibuprofen ,etc.), a medication authorization form needs to be completed each year. You may pick up a form in the school office or download one from the school website at www.flschool.org, Parents, Forms.
